Bethany Presbyterian Church – Community Meal Coordinator.....	\$1,893
Funds to purchase food and meal items (utensils, etc.) for meals served every Friday of the month, except the third Friday when Calvary Reformed Church hosts the meal.	
Boulevard Presbyterian Church – A New Day Youth Ministry.....	\$1,983
Funds to be used to pay a part-time youth minister (\$125/wk), background checks for volunteers, publicity, video licensing, additional T-shirts for new youth, Bibles for new youth, food, Vacation Bible School (curriculum and supplies), and bus rental for two (2) field trips.	
Brooklyn Presbyterian Church – Changing Colors, Changing Rainbows	\$2,500
Funds will be used to hire an instructor and pay for materials. The program serves people with autism and various multi-handicapping conditions.	
Care Alliance Health Center – Street Outreach Medical Program.....	\$6,000
Funds to be used to hire an additional Outreach Nurse for one year. Serve those who have no healthcare, homeless people, and others who struggle to bridge the many gaps in our healthcare network.	
Faith in Action – Handyman Ramp Project.....	\$2,343
Funds to be used to help continue with the existing handyman ramp project in Ashtabula County.	
Glenville Community Youth Center – Summer Youth Enrichment	\$2,000
Funds to be used to support the Summer Youth Enrichment Program, a six-week summer day camp for youth six to twelve years of age in the immediate Glenville area. Program also gives older youth job experience and training.	
Hunger Network of Cleveland – Hunger Network Liaison Project Health Care Initiative	\$1,765
Funds to be used to help remove barriers to healthcare for clients needing assistance.	
InterAct Cleveland – Homeless Stand Down.....	\$6,000
Funds to be used specifically for the day devoted to healthcare information, screenings, and services during the homeless stand down.	
Lorain Cooperative Ministry – Food Pantries, Hot Meals, etc.	\$2,793
Funds to be used to distribute food through a series of pantries, meals, and volunteers throughout Lorain County.	
Lutheran Metropolitan Ministry/START – Westhaven Youth Shelter.....	\$6,000
Funds to be used to help maintain the key position of Clinical Supervisor. Serves at-risk youth with healthcare needs.	
Northeast Ohio Alliance for Hope (NOAH) – East Cleveland Organizing Project	\$3,243
Funds to be used for expenses related to their nation Healthcare Reform work.	
North Coast Health Ministry – Medical Care Services.....	\$4,000
Funds to be used to help provide support for their medical care services, including chronic care management and prescription assistance. They serve low-income and uninsured patients.	
North Presbyterian Church – Homeless Outreach Program.....	\$4,000
Funds to be used for the support of their homeless ministry, which includes about half of the people who worship regularly at North.	
Providence House – Pediatric Medical Services Program	\$4,480
Funds to be used to fund medical care for approximately 40 at-risk infants and children in their residential program (\$112.00/child).	
UHCAN Ohio – Consumers as Partners in Improving Healthcare	\$4,000
Funds to be used to help mobilize efforts for healthcare reform.
